

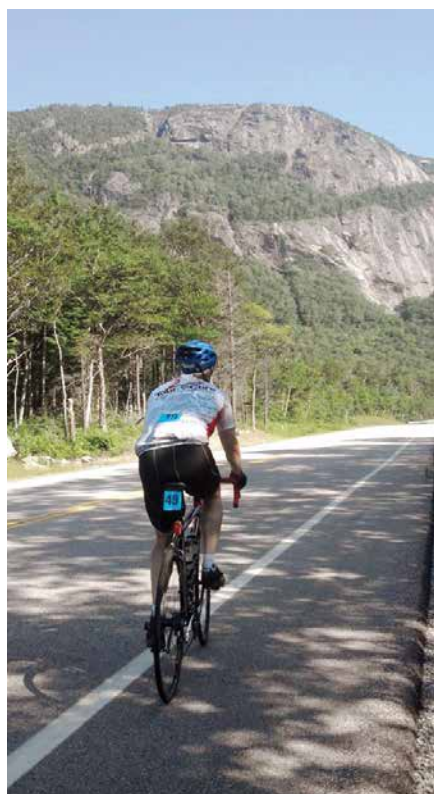

The [New England Classic](#) is a multi-day Tour de Cure fundraising event for the American Diabetes Association that offers two-day and seven-day options starting the same day in Bedford, Mass. The NEC 150 and NEC 550 travel the same route for the first two days. All New England Classic riders receive a NEC T-shirt and Tour de Cure cycling jersey

Two-Day New England Classic 150, July 14-15, 2018 – Goal: 125 riders



DISTANCE – 150 miles, Day 1: 80 miles;
Day 2: 70 miles
FUNDRAISING MINIMUM -- \$850
START: Bedford, Mass
ACCOMMODATIONS: University of New Hampshire dormitories
MEALS INCLUDED: Dinner on Day 1 and breakfast and dinner on Day 2
ROAD SUPPORT: Mechanics, SAG vehicles,

and well-stocked rest stops

FINAL DESTINATION: University of New England, Biddeford, Maine

RETURN TRANSPORTATION: Coach buses return riders to the start in Bedford. Their bicycles also are transported back to Bedford.

Seven-Day New England Classic 550, July 14-20, 2018 – Goal: 75 riders



DISTANCE – 550 miles. Shortest day: 69 miles; Longest day: just over 100 miles

FUNDRAISING MINIMUM -- \$2,700

START: Bedford, Mass.

SIX NIGHTS ACCOMMODATIONS INCLUDED: Indoor, air-conditioned dormitories, hotels and ski resorts

MEALS INCLUDED: Dinner, Days 1-6; Breakfast, Days 2-7

ROAD SUPPORT: Mechanics, SAG vehicles, and well-stocked rest stops
